What do SAGT volunteers do and how much time does each position require?

Serving as a campus liaison is a great way to get to know GT teachers and other SAGT volunteers. Another way to serve is working on a specific committee. Committee volunteers are voting Board Members. We have several committees of varying degrees of time commitment.

After you have experience on a committee, serving as an Officer of the Board is a highly- rewarding experience and opportunity to work directly with CISD's GT Coordinator to guide SAGT's mission. Refer to our Bylaws for specific duties for Officers of the Board.

Monthly meetings are held during the school year. Officers meet for an hour immediately before the monthly board meeting. Some years we meet on First Thursdays, some years are on First Fridays, depending on the availability of the Officers and CISD GT Coordinator. Monthly meetings begin at 11:30 and usually end by 12:45, but many volunteers come-and-go as needed.
