A Fun, Safe, Substance-Free Graduation Celebration

EVENT LOCATION & TIME:

The celebration will be held at MAIN EVENT ENTERTAINMENT, 407 W. State Hwy 114, Grapevine, TX on Friday, June 1, 2018. Doors will open at 11:00 PM and close at 12:15 AM. No one will be admitted after 12:15 AM. The party will end at 5:00 AM on June 2, 2017. Please note that parents of any student that purchased a ticket but does not check-in to the event will be notified by phone after the 12:15 AM check-in deadline.

Project Graduation is an all-inclusive party but only graduating seniors from the CSHS Class of 2018 may attend.

TICKET PRICES AND PURCHASE INFORMATION:

\$75 if received by May 11th at 11:00 pm (either online or received at CSHS)
\$85 if received by May 25th at 11:00 pm (either online or received at CSHS)
\$100 if received May 26th – May 29th at 11:00 pm (either online or received at CSHS)
\$100 if purchased at the door with waiver signed by both parent and student.

TO PURCHASE TICKETS:

1. OnLine. PG tickets can be purchased online on the "Class of 2018 - Seniors" page on the CSHS website. Click on the "Project Graduation Ticket Sales" link and follow the prompts. You can also purchase tickets on the "Dragon Payment links." You will be prompted to complete the "Student & Parent Contract and Release Form" on line. Students will NOT be admitted without completion of this contract and release form. You will receive a printed confirmation with important information about the evening.

OR

2. By Mail or Drop off at CSHS. PG tickets can be purchased by completing the enclosed "Student & Parent Contract and Release Form" signed by BOTH parent/guardian and Senior, and returning it with a check made out to CSHS-PTO Project Graduation (amount based on the Ticket Price Schedule above) in the envelope provided, to Carroll Senior High School, 1501 W. Southlake Blvd. Southlake, TX 76092, Attn: Project Graduation Tickets. Students will NOT be admitted without this contract and release form being on file.

OR

3. During Lunch at CSHS. PG volunteers will be at CSHS during lunch on Wednesday April 25 and Thursday April 26. Tickets can be purchased at that time with the completed "Student & Parent Contract and Release Form" signed by BOTH parent/guardian and student, and cash or check made to CSHS-PTO Project Graduation. Students will NOT be admitted without this contract and release form being on file.

EARLY DEPARTURE:

Graduates may leave the event at any time, however, **THEY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO RETURN AND WILL BECOME INELIGIBLE FOR ANY PRIZES OR CONGRATULATORY GIFT.** Note: parents will be notified by phone if a graduate leaves early.

ATTIRE:

The attire is casual. Graduates should dress comfortably and in accordance to school dress code.

VALUABLES and MEDICATIONS:

No backpacks, sleeping bags or blankets will be allowed! Ladies will be allowed a small purse if necessary but these items will be searched upon entrance. Graduates are strongly encouraged to leave valuables at home. Cash is not required as all food, drinks and entertainment will be provided by Project Graduation 2018. Any medications required during the duration of the event must be checked-in by the student upon arrival.

STUDENT IDENTIFICATION IS REQUIRED FOR ADMITTANCE:

All students MUST bring proper photo ID, a Driver's license or school ID, for admittance and to claim prizes.

- All Seniors are encouraged to purchase their tickets prior to the event: Advance tickets are \$75 until May 11. After the first deadline, tickets are \$85 until May 25. Tickets are \$100 from May 26-29 and can be purchased for \$100 (cash only) at the door on June 1. No one will be issued a ticket or allowed entry WITHOUT the Commitment Contract and Release Form completed online or on file.
- Admission into the celebration will require **Photo ID** for students. **No exceptions!** All seniors will arrive at Main Event no earlier than 11:00 PM and no later than 12:15 AM.
- Students will come to the event free of any drugs, alcohol or tobacco products and will not be admitted if it is suspected the student has already consumed drugs or alcohol. The use of any of these products during the celebration will result in immediate removal. The student's parent/guardian designated on the form below will be called to pick up any graduate who does not comply with the drug and alcohol policy. Students may be asked to take a breathalyzer test for admittance to event. Local police officers will be on site to deal with inappropriate behavior or violations of the law.
- Once at Project Graduation, all students are encouraged to stay for the duration of the party. If a student chooses to leave prior to 5:00 AM a parent or guardian must be notified of the student's early departure. We must verbally confirm you are aware of their departure, so please ensure your emergency phone number is accurate or they will not be able to leave. If released, graduates will not be allowed to re-enter Main Event.
- In case of illness, parents will be notified and transportation will be arranged accordingly.
- Students must attend the full duration of the event to be eligible for prizes and exit gift. Photo ID required for prize pick-up.
- Students will respect the event site and not engage in inappropriate behavior or cause malicious damage.
- Appropriate clothes must be worn. Clothing with pockets is suggested. Shirts and shoes are required.
- Smoking (including e-cigs and vaping) will not be permitted.
- Please be advised that all activities are PLAYED AT YOUR OWN RISK.
