Homeowner Appeals – There were no owners in attendance to appeal.

<u>Community Events</u> – Eileen reported that she spoke with McLendon's Hardware regarding a discount for the Association. They have agreed to donate gift cards to the Association which will be used for the Home Holiday Decoration contest.

She is also in the process of obtaining bids for the holiday decorating of the front entryway.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> - Ray discussed the proposed 2014 budget. There was discussion regarding dues, security credits and the money needed to help pay for the sinkhole repair in the park.

Adrian reported no change to the sinkhole after the last large rain storm.

Adrian reported that the cost sharing agreement negotiations with King County are ongoing. There were numerous verbal agreements made with an engineer who Adrian was led to believe had negotiating authority. When the revised agreement came back to Adrian for review it had significantly changed and was unacceptable for the Association.

This is an ongoing negotiation and will be taken to Regan Dunn's office if necessary.

<u>Covenant Enforcement</u> – The Board reviewed the homes in violation and the responses received.

Renter Enforcement – Nothing new to report.

Unfinished Business – Outstanding action items were reviewed.

New Business - Nothing new.

The meeting adjourned at 9:00 p.m. after a motion was made, 2nd and approved to adjourn.
