Purpose:

To financially assist young adults who exemplify true character and devotion to academics in their pursuit of higher education.

Mission Statement:

The mission of the George & Enid Brooks Foundation is to honor the vision of Bishop George and Enid Brooks, who believed in the intrinsic value of education and the ability of every child to achieve his/her God-ordained potential. We change lives through education, by providing scholarships to college-bound students in Paterson, NJ and support for elementary school students in the island nation of Jamaica.

History:

We presented our first scholarship in December 2007. Since then, we have increased the awards from one to two scholarships yearly. To date, we have awarded 14 scholarships to students attending college locally and nationally. Many of our alumni are working and volunteering in and around their communities, continuing in the spirit of community service that initially made them great candidates.

The George & Enid Brooks Foundation will continue to award scholarships on an annual basis to qualified high school seniors who live or attend school or church in Paterson, NJ and who actively participate in their church community and ministry.

- Be active in a minimum of one church ministry.
- Have completed a minimum of twenty (25) hours of community service, either within the church or in the community.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Complete the Scholarship Application Form.

Submit an Essay.

Include the following documentation:

- Documentation of enrollment or acceptance in the college or university you will be attending.
- Transcript and most recent report card including 2nd marking period of your senior year.
- Three reference names and telephone numbers: your pastor, a teacher or guidance counselor, and a community service contact.

THE ESSAY:

Write an essay about your educational, career, or personal goals. Describe your vision of how you will use your education to serve your community. <u>Essay length</u>: Minimum 500 words. Use your NAME and ESSAY as the title. **Ex: "JANE SMITH ESSAY"**
