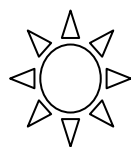

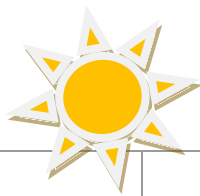
Again, SCYC cherishes the friends, family members, and students who have helped to make this school year a success.

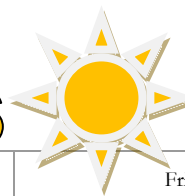
