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## Categories for 2018 NNNF Horticulture

Award Minimums: Best of Show \$18.00; 2nd place \$12.00; and 3rd place \$10.00

There will be ten (10) classes of produce judged. Classes two (2), five (5), and eight (8) will consist of two (2) sub-groups. A total of \$40 will be awarded in each class/group.

- Class 1: Field Crops (FC) Corn (white, blue, yellow, and sweet)
- Class 2: Field Crops (FC) Grass (Two Groups)
  - Group 1: Hay Alfalfa, Grass, and Oat
  - Group 2: Sorghum, Corn Stack, and Sunflower
- Class 3: Vegetables (VE) Leafy Vegetables (Lettuce, Cabbage, and Swiss)
- Class 4: Vegetables (VE) Root Vegetables (Beets, Carrots, Onions, Potatoes, and Egg Plants)
- Class 5: Vegetables (VE) Vines (Two groups)
  - Group 1: Summer Squash (Cucumbers, Straight Neck, etc.)
  - Group 2: Winter squash (Cucumbers, Straight neck, etc.)
- Class 6: Vegetables (VE) Rod Peppers (Bell Peppers, Jalapeno Big Jim, and Yellow Chile)
- Class 7: Vegetables (VE) Pod Vegetables (Tomatoes, Ripe, Cherry, Roma, and other Tomatoes)
- Class 8: Melon (ME) Vine Fruits (Two Groups)
  - Group 1: Watermelon (Crimson Sweet, Sugar Baby etc.)
  - Group 2: Melon (Cantaloupe, Honeydew, etc.)
- Class 9: Fruit (FR) Fruit Tree (Apple, Peaches, etc.)
- Class 10: Fruit (FR) Fruit Vine Crops (Strawberries, Grapes, etc.)

### **SPACE ASSIGNMENT**

Spaces will be assigned on a first come first served basis and marked by the Horticultural Coordinator at the time of registration during a participants entry. Additional set up and tear down time requested must be made in writing to the Horticultural Coordinator. Fire codes prohibit vendor spaces from exceeding their sizes and will be strictly enforced.
