

## SAYNER STAMPEDE USED STAMP SALE

### Lots of New Information for 2018 – Please Read Carefully

#### New Location:

The 2018 Used Stamp Sale will be held at the St. Germain Community Center – 545 State Highway 155. It is a short 10-minute drive from the Stampede Convention and offers more room, which was desperately needed.

#### New, Extended Hours – More Time to Shop:

New this year, the stamp sale will be open Friday, May 4 from 12:00 noon until 5:00 pm **AND** Saturday, May 5 from 8:00 am until 2:00 pm.

#### Who can sell at the used stamp sale?

Anyone may bring stamps and scrapbooking items to sell provided they follow the pricing and labeling rules below. IMPORTANT: If your sale items or your boxes/bins are not prepared as indicated, your items will not be put out for sale.

#### Prepping your items for sale:

Each individual item must be sealed in a ziplock bag with a 3 x 5" colored card (index card size) that contains your name, phone number, and the price of the item (see sample below). You set the price but, as a general rule. . . if you want to sell it, price it low. You will receive your price less a 15% fee (proceeds which will go toward next year's Stampede). All of your price cards must be uniform in color for all your items. The price card needs to be placed inside the ziplock bag. All prices need to be in increments of \$.25.

Large sale items (i.e. bins, large tools, etc.) - Put your name and phone number on a sticker somewhere on the item in case we lose the price card, then <u>securely</u> attach one of your price cards to the item, but not so much so that the cashier cannot remove it. We cannot be responsible for items that lose their price card. If you provide your name/phone number on the sticker we will make every attempt to contact you during the sale or return your item at the end of the sale.

#### Boxing your sale items:

All items being brought in for sale must be packaged in moderately sized boxes or plastic bins (not too heavy). No bags or totes. This year in addition to labeling your sale items, your boxes/bins need to be labelled as well. Attached is a template you can print, fill out with your information, and attach <u>securely</u> to one of the narrow ends of all of your boxes/bins. This will help streamline the sorting process at the end of the sale.

You can drop off your sale items at the following locations at the designated times:

- Payouts: As usual, you can pick up your leftover stamps and payment on Saturday after 4:00. Payments will be made in cash as much as possible, however, there is a chance you may be paid by check (mainly for the higher sales amounts). If for some reason we have to mail your check to you, make sure you have your complete, <u>legible</u>, name and address on your price cards. Anyone receiving a <u>cash</u> payment will have to show a picture ID before you will be paid.
- Looking for Volunteers: We are looking for a few volunteers to fill two-hour time slots at the sale on Friday and Saturday. Duties will range from setting up tables to picking up items that fall to the floor, keeping tables organized, keeping an eye on shoppers and sorting price cards.
