Congressman Michael McCaul to speak at September 8th Parent Empowerment Seminar!

ongressman Michael T. McCaul is currently serving his seventh term representing Texas' 10th District in the United States Congress. The 10th Congressional District of Texas stretches from Austin to the Houston suburbs, and includes Austin, Bastrop, Colorado, Fayette, Harris, Lee, Travis, Washington and Waller Counties. On January 3, 2013 - the beginning of the 113th Congress - Congressman McCaul became Chairman of the House Committee on Homeland Security. The Committee has oversight of the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) ensuring it is able to carry out its core mission of protecting the American people from terrorist attacks.

In addition to Chairman of Homeland Security, McCaul is a senior member of the House Foreign Affairs Committee, Chairman of the U.S.-Mexico Inter-Parliamentary Group (I.P.G.), founder of the Congressional Childhood Cancer Caucus, and co-founder of the Congressional High Tech Caucus and the Cybersecurity Caucus.



Congressman McCaul has also led efforts to combat human trafficking. Most recently, his bill – the *Department of Homeland Security Blue Campaign Authorization Act of 2017* – was signed into law. This law will better equip DHS to partner, educate, and coordinate efforts and intelligence sharing on multiple levels. It will provide resources to help deter, detect, and mitigate instances of human trafficking in our country. It will also safeguard victims and help raise public awareness of the threat human trafficking poses to our communities. McCaul continues to partner with officials, nonprofit organization leaders, and other advocates on the local, state, and federal levels to fight this modern-day slavery in Texas and across the country.
