Ms. Bizik has applied for a building permit to construct a residence on one of the properties and SCMCCI (Chris Hamilton) has requested clarification on property setbacks for the new structure. Chairman Ford suggested the minimum side yard setbacks of twenty (20) feet per 6.03 (A) be applied in this situation. There were no objections from the Planning Commission members and Chairman Ford will pass this information along to Ms. Hamilton.

 - 5) commercial uses in campgrounds 9.05(O)(3)
 - 6) light industrial uses in commercial zones 8.02 Industrial and
