

**SHERMAN TOWNSHIP SUPERVISOR'S BOARD MINUTES**  
**March 20, 2017**

The scheduled Supervisor's meeting was called to order at 7:00p.m. by Supervisor Steve Wolf.

Minutes from the February 20, 2017 meeting were presented. Motion by Roger Krontz to amend the minutes by changing verbage from Supervisor Wolf reopened Board meeting to Supervisor Wolf opened Budget Workshop meeting at 8:02P.M. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Gabe Weekly. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report presented by Laura Schwartz . Motion by Frank Iannarelli to accept the Treasurers report. . 2<sup>nd</sup> by Laura Schwartz . Motion carried.

Assessors Report - none

Committee Reports: Roger Krontz reported nothing new from SCMCCI. Frank Iannarelli reported that he attended meeting regarding the purchase of new voting machines. The State of Michigan will be purchasing these machines for the entire State at no costs to Townships. The first 5 years maintenance agreement is free and after year 5 the costs to Townships will be approximately \$700.00 per year for years 6 thru 10. After year 10, it is believed that new machines will be necessary.

Steve Wolf talked of filling Pot Holes in Sherman Township. He has had this conversation with Rodney Chupp. This is referred to as "Dust Control" and has been done before. After discussion it was agreed and a motion made by Steve Wolf that portions of Wall and Schrader Roads be attended to at a cost of \$1100.50 to Sherman Township. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Roger Krantz, motion carried.

#### New Business:

Mike Bobalick made presentation regarding a Website for Sherman Township. At this time, Supervisor Wolf, Treasurer Schwartz, and Clerk Iannarelli have been assigned logins. He will be reporting further on this subject at future meetings.

Discussion of a \$500.00 fee for Rezoning applications was discussed. After discussion, a roll vote was requested. Results, Weekly-no, Krantz-no, Wolf-no, Schwartz-no, Iannarelli-no. Fee will remain at \$250.00.

#### Unfinished Business:

In February 2017, County Road Commission received \$320,965.73. This was unexpected and un-announced. Road Commission would like to allocate these funds to road construction projects. It is understood that these funds will be available to Townships on a first come first serve basis. Supervisor Wolf to speak to Road Commissioner Minger about the repairs on Balk Road from Airline Road to Sherman Mills Road.

Motion by Frank Iannarelli that the Board approve Inspectors for the upcoming May 2 Election. These Inspectors are Frank and Nancy Iannarelli, Darrell and Elizabeth Puegeot, and Gloria Tate. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Steve Wolf. Motion carried.

Motion by Frank Iannarelli to pay the bills totaling \$13,432.52. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Laura Schwartz. Motion carried.

Motion by Steve Wolf to adjourn the meeting at 8:20 PM. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Laura Schwartz. Motion carried.

Supervisor Wolf opened Budget Workshop meeting at 8:37PM. Motion by Laura Schwartz to approve the new budget for year 2017/2018. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Frank Iannarelli. Roll call vote: Weekly-yes, Krantz-yes, Wolf-yes, Schwartz-yes, Iannarelli-yes. Motion carried.
