

SHERMAN TOWNSHIP SUPERVISOR'S BOARD MINUTES
August 21, 2017

The scheduled Supervisor's meeting was called to order at 7:00p.m. by Supervisor Steve Wolf.

Pledge of Allegiance was led by Supervisor Steve Wolf.

Rules of Meeting presented by Supervisor Steve Wolf.

Minutes from the July 17, 2017 meeting were presented. Motion by Steve Wolf to approve the minutes as presented. 2nd by Gabe Weekly. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report presented by Frank Iannarelli. Motion by Steve Wolf to approve report as presented. 2nd by Roger Krontz. Motion carried.

Supervisor Wolf opened meeting to Public Comment (limited to 3 minutes on any topic on the Agenda)

Supervisor Wolf closed the meeting to Public Comment

Old Bursiness: Kris Strawser made presentation regarding Fish Lake SAD. Steve Wolf made motion that Board approve SAD in the amount of \$164,000.00. Roll call vote : Weekly-yes, Krontz-yes, Wolf-yes, Iannarelli-yes. Motion carried. Also reported by Kris that there have been 8 Bass Tournaments on Fish Lake year to date. There is concern about behavior of participants and the fact that there are only 10 parking spaces at public access therefore there should only be 10 vehicles. Steve Wolf has contact person and will make contact with same regarding this subject.

Representative Miller suggests that Township and Planning Board start small and slow with concerns regarding Solar and Wind Farms. Planning Board needs to decide if they are "in or out" regarding this subject. Steve Wolf will address Planning Board.

Tax rate request (.5 millage or change) for Omena Lake residents was agreed to remain the same at .5 millage.

Lake Board for Lake Templene has been established and Steve Wolf will be Sherman Township representative.

Motion by Steve Wolf to accept Amendment for Ordinance 2017-17 establishing agreement with City of Sturgis and Sherman Township for electric usage for the next 30 years. 2nd by Frank Iannarelli. Motion carried.

Request for donation to Domestic and Sexual Abuse Services in the amount of \$801.25. This is the equivalent of .25 cents per resident in Sherman Township and matches the amount donated in previous years. Motion by Roger Krontz to approve donation, 2nd by Steve Wolf. Motion carried.

New Business:

Assessors Report – Dale Hutson – nothing to report.

Committee Reports: Gabe Weekly presented signed copies of all contracts with LifeCare Ambulance. Roger Krontz reported the Cease and Desist Order for Lake Area Christian School is still under discussion. Roger all presented pictures of Wind Mill Projects in other Townships. Reported that Rouch World would like campgrounds up and running as soon as possible. Also, there have been numerous accidents at the entry to Rouch World. Frank Iannarelli shared the invitation to Glen Oaks Community College Open House on August 25, 2017 from 4 to 6 PM.

Motion by Frank Iannarelli to pay the bills in the amount of \$34,205.87. 2nd by Steve Wolf. Motion carried.
