Steve Wolf reported to Board and Chris Hamilton several properties that are causing issues in Township. These properties include W. Fish Lake Rd., Burg Rd., Shimmel Rd., Wilson Rd., Northland Dr. Schrader Rd.

Old Business:

Master Plan Update- approximately 1600 surveys were mailed to residents with approximately 425 returned. There have also been several comments received with the surveys.

Lake Templene SAD – update – response from residents has been less than the required 60% approval rate. This topic may be reviewed again in 2019.

New Business – Secure Transportation License – Supervisor Wolf asked Board if they would be interested in Township offering several license to Sherman Township residents for the purpose of obtaining a “Secure Transportation License” for the purpose of transporting “medical Marijuna”. Sherman Township would receive up to \$5,000.00 per license issued per year. Much discussion with the consensus that Board needs more information. This topic will again be on Agenda for September 2018 meeting.
