30 bird race

Club opens at 12:00 Noon for practice until 1:30 PM.

Race starts 2:00 PM.

Shooting to follow as lighting permits until 8:00 PM.

Main Event Saturday and Sunday, May 5 - 6

High Over All based on 60 targets.

30 targets each day from 26 meters.

Each day serves as separate Selection Match for USHA members attempting to qualify for the 2018 United States Helice Team.

Awards to the HOA Champion, Concurrent HOA Champions, and Daily High Gun Award.

Saturday, May 5: Practice from 9:15 AM until 10:30 AM. Race starts at 11:00 AM. After shooting on Saturday, the Dallas Gun Club will provide complimentary hors d'oeuvres and cocktails, followed by a Review of Guns.

General Information:

- All purses and options are non-compulsory. Shooters may participate for entry fees only.
- Purse and option payouts to be based on actual event scores (not high gun). All ties divide.
- Must not have placed in top five (5) places in any prior event to be eligible to enter the Hunter's Purse.
- Heaviest shot charge allowed for competition is 1 oz., largest shot size is 7 ½. Factory ammunition only.



- Helice practice targets shall be available for \$3.00 each.
- USHA rules shall apply.
- Vets ages 55-64, SuperVets 65 or older, Juniors 20 or younger.
- Calcutta purchases must be paid for in cash prior to the start of Sunday's event.

From DFW Airport: take the North Exit to State Highway 121 North and continue on State Highway 121 Bypass towards McKinney, exit at Lake Vista / McArthur and turn right on the I-35 South service road.



The club entrance is 100 yards on the right. It is unmarked and has a sliding, automatic gate.

From downtown Dallas: take I-35 north. Exit #447B - 121 Grapevine / McKinney. Make a U-turn and get back on the southbound service road.

The club entrance is 100 yards on the right. It is unmarked and has a sliding, automatic gate.

From Denton: take I-35 south. Exit # 448A - 121 Grapevine / McKinney. Go through the intersection and continue on the service road.

The club entrance is 100 yards on the right. It is unmarked and has a sliding, automatic gate.
