The committee has developed the following plan:

- Tables shall be throughout the area with PPE (Personal Protective Equipment), including masks, hand sanitizer, and wipes.
- Children will receive hand sanitizer before and after rides.
- No "bouncy houses" due to their enclosed spaces.
- Vendors are requested to "strongly" consider masking.
- All Vendors, including Falcon Lane Vendors, will be given extra space to promote social distancing.
- Wipes and Hand Sanitizer on each sitting table in Whalen Commons.
- Face masks are not required but recommended.
- Signage throughout the festival as a reminder of Covid-19 Guidelines.
