Tournament Rules

All tournaments are to follow the fishing regulations in their respective areas.

- Three people per team, (two must be 17 years old or younger), proof of age may be required.
- All Alberta sport fishing Regulations must be adhered to. All provincial & federal fishing & boating acts & regulations must be observed unless more stringent rules are specified by the tournament committee. Entrants must possess the applicable fishing license. Anyone caught breaking these regulations may be disqualified.
- Registration and rules review will take place the morning of the tournament 1 ½ hours prior to blast off. Fishing hours will be from 9:00AM - 2:30 PM commencing by a trickle start. Any team returning late may be disqualified.
- Your tether kill switch strap must be worn at all times of travel above idle speed.
- Livewell and kill switch operation inspection will take place from 7:45AM - 8:15 AM at the main dock and every team's boat must be operational. End of the day livewell check **mandatory**.
- A maximum of 1 walleye (greater than 50cm) per angler will be eligible for weigh in.
- Each team is only allowed 2 walleye in their live-wells at one time. This will create two weigh –in during the day at an offshore weigh-in station. Only 2 walleye can be weighed in at one time & all walleye brought to the weigh in station must be weighed.
- No fizzing
- Stressed fish will be penalized by 25%, dead fish will be disqualified.
- Angling is not permitted within 150m radius of the release boat.

- Prizes will be awarded in order of the team's heaviest weight overall and awarded to the angler and young angler on a separate basis. In the case of a tie, the team's heaviest fish will determine the winner, or via a coin toss.

• **Everyone must wear their life jacket at all times.**

- Every team must be present for a group photo at the end of the championship.
- In order to be eligible for prizes each team must return and report to the main dock by no later than 2:30PM.
- Prizes will be awarded at approximately 5:00 P.M. following the BBQ.
- Any disputes will be settled by the Event Director, and not the Lund AYA Organization.
- Up to 50 entries on a first come - first serve basis.

Adverse Weather Contingency Plan Foul weather will be determined by lightning or winds over 30km. In the event that foul weather forces a cancelation of fishing on Saturday, the tournament will become a raffle at the Tournament Head Quarters.
