



Mt Tabor Ghost Walk FAQs

1. Is there an age limit as to who could attend the ghost walk?
Yes, the age limit is for Ages 8 and up.
2. Are there refunds due to weather?
The Ghost Walk will happen rain or shine so dress accordingly. Big umbrellas are discouraged! Rain ponchos are cool and are the way to go!
3. Is the entire Ghost walk outside?
Yes! Except for the beginning of the tour where you will check-in, in the Tabernacle. The entire walk is outdoors.
4. How long is the ghost walk?
The entire experience is approximately one hour long. You are to arrive 15 minutes before your walk time so that you can check-in, in the Tabernacle. Once your guide calls for your group, you will start your walk. The walk is approximately 35 minutes long. We also have a gift shop where you can purchase gift items or get a card reading at the end of the walk.
5. Do you allow pictures and or videos at this event?
Absolutely no video or pictures are allowed on the ghost walk since these are private homes. However, photo opportunities are available outside the Tabernacle where a ghoul or two will be stationed for photos!
6. Is there a cost for the photos?
Taking photos at these stations are free. There is a suggested donation but not required.
7. Will there be food allowed on ghost walk?
No food or drinks are allowed while on the ghost walk but there will be snacks and drinks available outside of the Tabernacle throughout the evening that can be purchased.
8. Should I bring a jacket?
Autumn nights can be cool. We suggest bringing a light jacket.
9. Are back packs allowed?
No back packs are allowed and not necessary for this event. Bags should be left in the car or at home.
10. Should I bring a flashlight?
Yes, flash lights are recommended but not required since the route is well lit and the guide will have a flashlight. Flashlights would enhance the ghost walk experience.
11. How scary is the walk?
The walk gets scarier as the night progresses. Fear is relative. We will try our best to make your skin creep and crawl. There are many opportunities throughout the ghost walk where some unexpected occurrences may jump out at you so be aware and alert.
