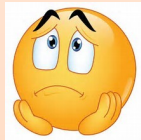
A Biblical Story

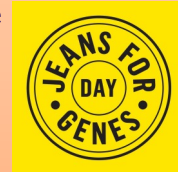
(3) A big welcome to Carol who has joined the Kepplegate team and will be working as assistant cook
