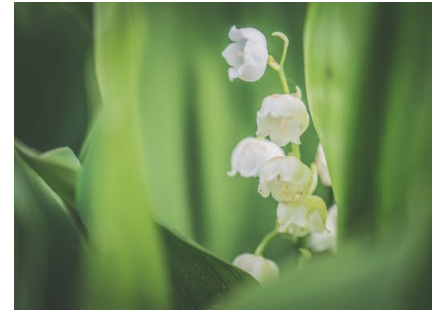

BIRTHDAYS

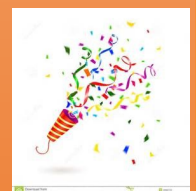


Many happy returns to Alf and May who celebrated birthdays during May.
