Raising the Roof

You might have noticed some issues around the building where water ingress has caused damage to walls and tiling. The problem is a leaky roof!

In recent years, a number of minor patches have been applied, but what's now needed is some major work on the roof. Without this, we're going to suffer continuing problems in reception, the ladies' showers and other areas. The work needed to the roof will cost in the region of £20,000, and there will then be costs to repair the consequent damage. We therefore aim to raise £30,000 to fund the roof repairs then further renovation and maintenance costs.

We plan to obtain some grant funding towards this, but this is likely to be available on a matched basis – so could you help us out?

We've started a "Repair fund" and you could help by making a donation – any amount, large or small. By taking advantage of the Government's "Gift Aid scheme, if you pay tax, you can increase the value of your donation at no extra cost. Just ask us for a form.

Or why not hold a fundraiser for us? Hold a coffee morning in your home, or do a sponsored swim at the pool. Or volunteer to help at one of our fundraisers advertised at the pool – and do let us know if your employer offers matched funding. Every little helps! If you have an idea to help, please let us know.
