North F Dock Repairs

As some of you may recall last winter and spring we had three major wind storms pass through our area. Each one of the windstorms caused damage to the north side of F dock. Staff has been busy filing insurance claims, soliciting bids and hiring a company to make the repairs.

Within the next few weeks, Neptune Marine will be bringing in a large barge to do some preliminary work and planning. Then on October 31st Neptune Marine will start to make the repairs. In addition to the large barge they will be bringing in several small support boats. Neptune Maine will be repairing the walls and patios at F 6/7, 8/9, 10/11, 12/13 and 14/15. They will be working from 8:00 – 5:00 Monday – Friday and estimate the repair to take anywhere from 20 – 30 working days.

In order to ensure safety for all of our north F dock tenants, we will be relocating all of the boats on the north side of F dock to the south side. We are already notifying our north F dock tenants of their new temporary slip assignments and ask that everyone be moved to the temporary slip by October 8th. Once the repairs have been completed you will be notified and can move back to your north F dock slip.
