

# **Basic Boating Class**

The Deception Pass Sail & Power Squadron in partnership with the Oak Harbor Yacht Club will be offering a Basic Boating class. Successful completion of the course will qualify individuals for the Washington State Boater Education Card now required for most boaters.



This is the only basic class being offered this spring.

This two-day introductory boating class will be held at Saint Stephens Episcopal Church and is scheduled for April 7 & 14. The classes will go from 9:00 - 3:00 each day. A light lunch will be provided to students on both days.

The cost of the class is \$55.00 and if your spouse or partner wants to share material it is an additional \$20.00
