

Bertin Family Foundation Scholarship

The Bertin Family Foundation Scholarship was established with the graduating class of 2009 at Bountiful High School. Kim and Jennifer Bertin want to give back to their community and provide an incentive for young people. They also want to reward good students who don't receive a major scholarship despite great effort. Their generosity and commitment to education is evident in this significant scholarship. By contributing \$2,000 a year for four eligible years toward the recipient's education, the Bertin Family Foundation awards a total of \$8,000 per recipient. This contribution is deposited directly toward tuition at the recipient's university.

Qualifications The scholarship candidate should:

Be a current senior at Bountiful High School who plans on earning a college/university degree.

Maintain a 3.3 or greater cumulative GPA and a score greater than 22 on the ACT

Demonstrate extensive leadership /extra-curricular/ service experience.

Have acceptance into a college/university.

Not have received another significant scholarship. (half-tuition or more disqualifies applicants)

Application Procedure Prepare a three-prong folder with the following items:

Cover Page: Bertin Family Foundation Scholarship, your name, address, phone number, email, college/university of acceptance, projected field of study, and list any scholarships already received.

Transcript: Print out a current copy from myDSD.

Summary of involvement: List involvement in the following three areas.

1) Leadership Experience 2) Extra-curricular activities 3) Community Service

Essay Portion: Write one page responses to each of the following questions.

What are your educational and professional goals, and what people and experiences have influenced these choices?

Identify and relate how your life has been influenced by one or two community endeavors in which you have participated?

How can a college/university education strengthen families and communities?

Letters of recommendation: Acquire two letters from people of your choice, although at least one should come from a Bountiful High School teacher.

**Completed scholarship application folders should be turned in to Mr. Munk,
no later than 2:30 PM on the second Friday of April.**

Applicants will be screened and a final group of candidates will be selected for interviews in early May.
