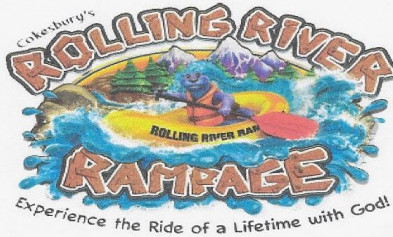
### **Hygiene Kits**

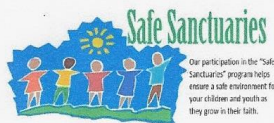
