

UMCOR SUNDAY, MARCH 31st The United Methodist Church has six special Sundays. Through St. Mark's mission fund, our church makes a small donation to each, when it occurs each year. UMCOR stands for the United Methodist Committee on Relief. This Sunday used to be called One Great Hour of Sharing & is celebrated on the fourth Sunday in Lent. 




