





Our first donation request is for individual fruit punch & juice drink boxes and individual snack bags of chips, cookies, crackers & fruit snacks (any flavor).


Do you have some farm items we can borrow for decorating? Perhaps a tractor or an empty chicken coop? Look for a full list in next week's bulletin!
