





The Talbot Interfaith Shelter (TIS) is a temporary shelter serving homeless individuals from Talbot County & surrounding areas. The congregation of St. Mark's has supported TIS since its inception. Currently we provide morning (7am to 10am) & evening (7pm to 11pm) supervision as well as dinner on the 23rd & 24th of each month. Over these years our list of volunteers has declined.
