Judging assignments may be adjusted to allow load balancing after the close of entries.

Any assignment change will be noted in the judging program and provided to all competitors. Judging schedule will be sent to exhibitors after closing.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word “dog” is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, the dog displays no sign of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Deaf and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Females in season may not participate, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from an injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance may not participate. No dog shall compete if it is sutured, bandaged, or has any visible wounds.

No entries will be accepted by phone, email, or fax. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to **Lauren Beyer** at sw@BlueSkye.net. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

STAGING AREA AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Staging Area will be out of view of search area(s). Staging area will include crating, warm-up and waiting area, as well as a table for check-ins and posting of running order and results.

The Handler's Briefing will be an individual briefing on the search line. The judge will explain if there is an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search.

Warm-up area will be available consisting of ONE container of Birch, Anise, Clove, and Cypress, as appropriate, and may also consist of blank containers. Exhibitors should limit their warm-up to (2) two minutes or less. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the handler-dog team prior their run. The warm-up area is not for training or relieving of the dog.

SEARCH AREA AND RING CONDITIONS

Search Area Conditions: Search areas may be of any shape, and of the size specified in the Regulations for each class. These trials will be held in a large, covered, open sided structure. The location is ADA accessible. The surface is paved but not smooth; some irregularities exist.

Search Area Sizes will be as follows: Container Novice (250-400sqft.), Advanced (400-600sqft.), Excellent (600-800sqft), Master (600-800sqft); Buried Novice (150-200sqft.), Advanced (150-200sqft.), Excellent (200-300sqft.), Master (400-50sqft.).

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Trial Site. It is not appropriate to visit the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

Possession of Odors and Training. Chapter 5, Section 26 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area".

Crating Will be from the car. There is no shade. Be prepared with shade covers, fans, etc. Cars should not be left running. The Dog Fanciers Association of Oregon and Mulino Elementary School will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Spectator Area. Spectators are encouraged. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run except in the case of Handler Discrimination classes. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide. Spectators who intentionally or unintentionally give aid to a team may be ask to leave the area by the judge. Spectators are forbidden to discuss details of the search with handlers who have not run.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Placement ribbons will be awarded in each class as follows:

First Place.....	Blue
Second Place.....	Red
Third Place.....	Yellow
Fourth Place.....	White
Qualifying Score.....	Dark Green

A New Title ribbon will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing an element title.

Teams earning a New Elite Title will be awarded a rosette.
Teams earning a New Level Title will be awarded a rosette.

TRIAL SPECIFIC INFORMATION

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN: Check in using Agility Gate, the gate steward can assist you, if needed. Upon arrival pick up your scribe sheets from the registration table. Scribe sheets are organized by handler last name.

Exhibitors MUST check-in EACH trial they are entered.

THE HANDLER'S BRIEFING: Each handler will receive an individual briefing from the judge at the start line. In the Handler's Briefing the judge will explain if there is an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search.

AWARDS: Preliminary results will be posted as soon as the runs are entered. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded in the ring. Placement and title ribbons will be available in the staging area.

PARKING: Please follow the signs when you arrive. Plan to provide shade for your vehicle. Cars should not be left running. Due to high fire danger, NO Smoking on the property.

DOGS IN UNVENTILATED VEHICLES

All persons attending this dog event hereby waive any claim for damages against the Dog Fanciers Association of Oregon, Inc. or its members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

Provide your own food and drinking water. There will be wading pools and misters available for the dogs. Please clean up after yourself and your dogs. You are responsible for taking all of your garbage with you when you leave. There will be limited receptacles for dog droppings, anyone not picking up after their dogs will be asked to leave the grounds.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The **safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Dog Fanciers Association of Oregon and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Dog Fanciers Association of Oregon reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Dog Fanciers Association of Oregon or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses. During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times, and retractable leashes may not be used on show grounds. Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund.

Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

NO DOGS wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class, unless specifically allowed for in AKC Rules & Regulations.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

The Dog Fanciers Association of Oregon, Inc. does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

VOLUNTEERS

Job Descriptions

*Note: many volunteer positions require walking, standing and bending. *Sit down jobs available*

- **Element Setup** – Assists in the setup for assigned element, at the Judge's direction, including line of site, start lines, boundary marking.
- **Clean Up** – Site preparation for the next day, removal and loading of all trial gear at Trial(s) completion.
- ***Judge's Steward** – Bring competitors to the start line, remind them of the time limit and leash options for the search.
- ***Timer** – Timing competitor runs. ***Gate Steward** – Managing competitors run order/flow for the trial element area, assisting competitors positioning pre-search.
- **Hide Steward (includes Hot Box Steward)** *must wear latex or nitrile gloves when handling odor containers/boxes, etc. to prevent contamination* – Handles and places hides for those classes the judge requires a hide steward, including moving or adjusting hides during a class *at the Judge's direction*. Handles/sets warm-up boxes. Clean up between buried hide competitors may be required, including sweeping, vacuuming, or returning spilled soil or sand to the container.
- **Score Runner** – Carries score sheets from search areas to Score Table throughout the trial.
- **Registration** – Check-in of arriving Competitors and Volunteers. Assistance at Score Table with verification of score sheet completion before data entry.
