



#### CRITIQUE OF THE 2ND GDDC SPECIALTY SHOW ENTRY

August 16, 2019 Linda Hazen Lewin, Conformation Judge

First, I want to thank the members of the Greater Denver Dalmatian Club for selecting me to judge your specialty show. It was an honor to be asked to judge this fine entry and if the quality of the dogs, the terrific venue in Greeley, and your club's unsurpassed hospitality are any example, I predict even more great things for GDDC and all of its members going forward!

As many of your are aware, I often provide a class-by-class commentary of the entry I judge at specialty shows. This was my full intention at the GDDC specialty as well, however, due to the late start of judging at the morning

shows which resulted in a delayed start of all of the afternoon events, I was instructed by the AKC rep to restrict the recording of my comments to after Winners Dog, after Winners Bitch and after Best of Breed. In that light, please accept my apologies for this rather foreshortened critique.

General observations: I was mightily impressed with the overall quality of the entry at this show and I do not make such a comment lightly. In class after class, I saw uniformly typey, sound and beautiful animals to choose from, prettily decorated, and well off for true breed expression and temperament. The Best of Breed line-up was spectacular and compelled me to make my choices based on true minutiae. In the end, I would presume that my preference for an elegant yet sturdy Dalmatian

of moderate size and beautiful type, which is clean coming and going, and with a ground-covering and efficient side gait, became evident throughout the show as I judged.

Following are my observations of my final choices:

**WINNERS DOG:** From the 6-9 month Puppy class – Matchless & Dal's Alley All Roads Lead to Rome: A typey, wellmade youngster with excellent balance in front and rear angulation which manifested in his elastic and ground-covering side gait. Wonderful bone and feet on this boy, he was in charge of himself going around the ring despite his youth, and was absolutely clean going straight away and back. A good level topline, croup and tailset which he carried in motion as well as standing. He has a lovely, masculine head piece, and is well off in cosmetics with an attractive spotting pattern and dark-dark eyes. This boy was also my Best Puppy winner.

#### **RESERVE WINNERS DOG: From**

the Open, Black-Spotted class – Quicksilver Fast and Fleuryous: Another pretty, typey male, vividly-marked, with a very nice shoulder and hindquarter. Plenty of reach and drive going around, with a good, level topline and croup and correct tailset and carriage. Nice bone and feet as well, this boy gave way to my Winners Dog only in being a tiny bit longer in the loin. A top-quality dog on all points, I was happy to award him Reserve in a very competitive lineup.



**WINNERS BITCH:** From the Bred By Exhibitor class - MV ME Desert Fury Going To Knock You Out: Well, she did! Knock me out, that is. Her perfect balance and outline drew my attention immediately. Plenty of angulation front and rear lent her a reaching-driving side gait which was also clean on the downand-back. Excellent topline, croup and tail, with a beautiful head type and pretty markings to boot, she was always presented at her best speed. While I would have liked a bit darker eye color, this bitch's many virtues of type, structure, movement and markings placed her at the top of a very strong bitch entry. This girl ended the day as Best of Winners and Best Bred By Exhibitor. I was informed later that this win finished her championship, with her 4th major!

#### **RESERVE WINNERS BITCH:**

From the 12-18 Month class – Hallmark Nspird Eye Candy: A lovely girl of a pretty type, somewhat heavier-marked than my Winners Bitch, with an elegant outline. Another vigorous, ground-covering mover, she only gave way to my Winners Bitch in that she was a bit longer-bodied. She had a nice long neck to go with it, though, and I was happy to award her the Reserve placement in what was an extremely competitive entry of bitches.

**BEST OF BREED:** There was so much depth of quality in the BOB line-up and I was very pleased with my final choices. That said, there were several other entrants which would have easily received acknowledgment on another day.

GChS All Around Funny Girl of Riverside: A gorgeous liver-spotted bitch of perfect balance and outline, always shown at her best speed, this girl looks every inch the coach dog. Smooth, effortless movement with no hitch, roll or compensation for faulty structure anywhere, she filled my eye. Moderate in size with correct ribspring and depth of brisket for the desired heart and lung room, she shows strong coupling through the loin, a level topline and croup, and correct tailset and carriage. Feminine in character without frailty or weakness of any sort, this bitch has the best shoulder placement and angulation as well as a correct, driving hindquarter which she puts to good use. Well off in head type, color and marking pattern, this

bitch would serve equally well in

all the functions of a proper coach

dog with all of the stamina, functionality and style the job demands.

**BEST OF WINNERS (THE WINNERS BITCH):** Not to be denied this day, the Winners Bitch is much the same type and style as my Best of Breed girl, in a black-and-white package. Showing me once again her wonderful side gait, steady topline, proper head and tail carriage, and presented always at her best speed, she is also the kind of no-nonsense, workmanlike bitch who illustrates what it is to be a correct and useful coach dog. Feminine, sound, steady in gait and temperament, lovely color and markings, correct outline and balance, type-y head piece, excellent bone and feet, this exhibit was Best of Winners today.





'n Adventureland Star Coach: A stunning black-and-white dog with a remarkable combination of type, balance, movement and cosmetics. Masculine without coarseness, this boy has a beautiul headpiece and wonderful expression, with a good dark eye. He is moderate in size and covers the ground with a wide-open, sweeping side gait. Exellent running gear with correct bone and feet, this dog topped the males today in a highly competitive line-up.

SELECT DOG: GCh. Satin'n Cimarron Up'n At'm: While a different style of Dalmatian from my Best of Opposite Sex winner, this black-and-white dog carries handsome type, correct structure, vivid markings and ground-covering movement. He is well up on leg and shows great style in motion. A bit more sloped in his topline than I generally prefer, he levels out nicely in motion and uses his strong hindquarter and well-laid

shoulder efficiently. Every inch a useful and attractive coach dog, he was well worthy of this award in tough competition.

SELECT BITCH: GChS MV ME Pride of the Desert: What a darling! Super-cute liver bitch with lovely markings and tons of personality. As with all of my winners, she showed me excellent movement from the side as well as coming and going. Smooth in outline and stylish in carriage, her jaunty demeanor made her a stand-out today. I was informed later that this bitch is the dam of my Winners Bitch.

#### **AWARD OF MERIT: GChS**

Trailspotter 'n Summit's Big Slick, CA BCAT: with all of the traits that have made me happy all day, this black-and-white boy attracted my notice right away with his correct balance, shoulder and hindquarter, attractive markings and wonderful head and expression, all in a moderate-sized package. I have long admired this dog and was happy to present him with an Award of Merit in today's stiff competition.

#### AWARD OF MERIT:

Ch. Melody Guns Afire: The Veteran Dog, a stately liver-spotted fellow who showed clearly how this breed should age! While a bit proud of his tail, he was sound-moving, in command of himself, and with plenty of eye-appeal. I was pleased to award him this recognition today. Once again, my deep appreciation to the members and friends, officers and Board of GDDC, and to all who entered their dogs under me. It was

my pleasure and honor to judge them.

\*Linda Lewin has been in dogs since the early 1970's, beginning with Dalmatians, and has produced American, Canadian and Japanese champions in that breed. In the mid-1990's, she added Standard Manchester Terriers to her crew, and has produced many champions and Group placers/winners in that breed as well.

She is an AKC-approved judge of Dalmatians, Poodles and Junior Showmanship and has judged at many of the regional Dalmatian specialties around the country as well as the Dalmatian Club of America's National Specialty Shows. She has judged all varieties of Poodles at many shows around the country. As a former member of the Mid-Atlantic Stewards Association, Linda has long experience stewarding in both the conformation and obedience rings.

Linda has designed and conducted Judges Breed Study Groups and educational seminars for judges and breeders, including presenting the Dalmatian Study Group at the Advanced Judges Institute in Indiana, PA many times. She is a parent club-approved mentor for both Dalmatians and Manchester Terriers.

When not showing, stewarding, judging, or writing about all of that, Linda works as a project and acquisition scheduler in support of the U.S. Army.
