DEGENERATIVE MYELOPATHY

and the Boston Terrier

Somewhere along the way, the Boston Terrier breed got dragged kicking and screaming into the dreaded DM plague of 2014. It swallowed dozens upon dozens of breeds that had, to the best of experienced breeders' knowledge, never been plagued by it before.

For those unfamiliar with Degenerative Myelopathy, this is a disease where, very simply put, parts of the spinal cord degenerate, hindering communication between the hind limbs and the brain. Onset is usually between 8 and 12 years of age, begins slowly, and for the most part painlessly, to reduce functionality of the rear legs. It is a fatal disease typically within three years, with many owners opting for euthanasia in one year due to total loss of rear function. It can only be definitively

diagnosed once the dog is deceased, by examining the spinal cord during a necropsy. Living dogs can only be diagnosed through a process of elimination, and since there are many problems that can affect the spine, it can be a lengthy process and in the end, the diagnosis is still a well educated guess. Breeds that are prone to the disease are often diagnosed without going through the full process of elimination, simply based on the fact that it's "likely" to be DM. The OFA website

lists 17 breeds "at risk" for DM. The Boston Terrier is not one of them. Research online will again show about 17 breeds listed on most sites as being at risk. The only sites that clearly suggest the Boston Terrier is one of those breeds are the genetics labs who sell the testing kits for DM.

In the fall of 2014, posts by one particular lab specifically featuring the Boston Terrier started appearing, encouraging owners to test because Bostons "may carry genes for DM". Then

as breeders went to the websites of the various labs to test for JHC, a new option to bundle the JHC and DM tests appeared on some of them as a "breed specific" test. How does this happen? How does a disease crop up overnight without the knowledge of experienced breeders? And without involvement of the BTCA and their Health Committee in educating breeders of this genetic disorder that we should be preventing? It doesn't. But we will get to that in a moment.

News of this test for Bostons spread like wildfire. While experienced breeders were scratching their heads at this new oddity, others took to the

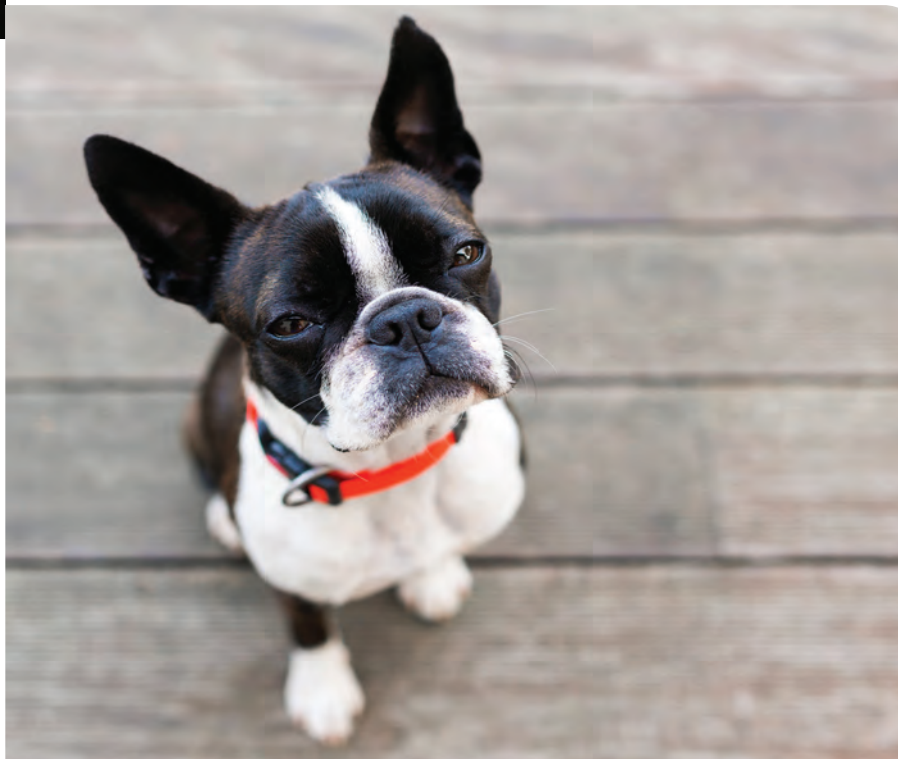
forums preaching of the value of this new test. Fueled by posts from owners whose Bostons suffered from any type of spinal issue, the notion that Bostons were at risk gained momentum. Cheek swabs (and money... lots of money) poured into the genetics labs as breeders rushed to get their dogs tested and cleared so they could proudly show their negative test results. And again, experienced breeders wondered, "How did we get here?!"

Here's how. In 2014 a study was published regarding the SOD1 gene (DM) and the mutations potentially responsible for some breeds being more at risk for developing the disease. 222

different purebred breeds were tested with the Boston Terrier being one of them. The dogs were chosen for their respective breeds based upon the assertion from the owner that the dog was a purebred. To quote the study, "This included 1,368 mixed-breed dogs and 32,378 dogs claimed by their owners to be purebred representatives of 222 different canine breeds." Read that again... "claimed by their owners to be purebred". We have all seen dogs "claimed by their owners to be purebred" that are undeniably mixed breeds. So the "Bostons" used in this study are already questionable right from the start.

But let's move on to the results. The number of dogs ranged from just 1, to nearly 6500 dogs in each breed. Only 14 Boston Terriers total were used. Out of those 14, 13 were clear, 0 were carriers, 1 was affected. This resulted in a .07 frequency. The researchers themselves did not seem to consider this relevant enough to include in their final report, so Bostons and all others that registered only a "blip" in the study, were left out of the results. It should have ended there don't you think?

No, the testing labs seemed to have another take on the study and every one of those breeds



that registered a blip, were added to the breeds affected by DM. OFA lists 17 affected breeds. One particular testing lab says that now there are 192. And each one of those breeds has DM listed and part of the bundle for the “suggested” and “breed specific” tests. The CEO and founder of one particular company was seen on a forum, making the very bold statement that “One in fourteen Boston Terriers is affected with Degenerative Myelopathy”, citing the very minimal results from this particular study, and making a very bold claim based on very questionable evidence. If one can determine 1 in 14 Bostons

is affected based on that single study, one could also say that the breed has 0 carriers. This is not how proof is determined in the world of science. I can’t speak for these labs, however 192 breeds testing for DM is a far cry more profitable than just 17. No one is forcing anyone to test, but I personally feel it is the responsibility of any organization deemed as “experts” to make statements that are as accurate as possible.

But all testing is good testing, right? Well sure. I could test all of my Bostons for “Collie eye” too, but I personally wouldn’t feel that bragging rights are in

order. It does not hurt to test, however what we are witnessing with the “sky is falling” attitude towards DM in Bostons, is breeders who usually only test for JHC, getting distracted by a test for an issue that frankly doesn’t appear to exist in the breed, while continuing to neglect the other tests that they desperately need. Much like a group of people at risk for diabetes who should be getting checked for a very real problem, running out to get their thumbs checked instead. It doesn’t hurt to check their thumbs, but while they’re all feeling good about having healthy thumbs, their focus was distracted from what

is vitally important. In my opinion, if someone wants to test for DM, they should have BAER/JHC/Trachea/Spine and current CAER, Patella and Cardiac tests completed first. But this is not the case with most breeders testing for DM. The appeal of yet another “walk to the mailbox test” has sucked in many breeders that have already refused to leave their homes to get the rest of the recommended tests completed. It gives a false sense of security and false bragging rights for now doing multiple tests on their breeding dogs rather than just one. Again, testing for DM does not hurt, but I feel it’s a distraction.

Or does it actually hurt to test? I’ve seen a handful say that their Bostons have tested as carriers. I have not yet seen proof of any in show lines, though there is rumor of one or two in Europe. Those said to be carriers here in the US are often from unknown backyard breeding, or dogs with disqualifying color faults where mixed breeding is often suspected. In much searching, I have yet to find one confirmed case of an affected and symptomatic Boston with DM. Most are found to be herniated discs or hemivertebrae, not Degenerative Myelopathy. DM is an odd duck, in that even a dog that tests affected may never be symptomatic.

So back to my thoughts on the breed actually being “hurt” by testing. What if, for all these years, the Boston has always had the occasional carrier or the occasional genetically affected but for some reason the gene is present but not activated in our breed? Research has not yet determined all of the factors involved in why it’s active in some dogs and breeds and not others. When JHC plagued our breed and we had no testing, we KNEW that there was an issue and we KNEW we needed a solution. With DM, we are not seeing a problem. We never have. So why does now having a test suddenly mean that what we know to be true is no longer true?

I saw a beautiful dog in Europe posted with negative test results for DM proudly displayed with his photo. He is a gorgeous, well put together dog with a lot going for him. Let me play Devil’s Advocate for a moment and say, “what if”. What if his test results had said he was a carrier? What if many other extremely nice and healthy Bostons tested as carriers? Do we prevent their quality and health from being

added to the gene pool and spay and neuter them all when for well over 100 years we knew there was no problem with DM affecting our Bostons? Why would we eliminate outstanding dogs from our gene pool now? I’d venture to say that “throwing the baby out with the bathwater” doesn’t quite cover that scenario since DM hasn’t even dirtied the water. It’s like just throwing out a perfectly happy, healthy, clean and dry baby. Period.
