KENYA WRITING WORKSHOPS

>> Classroom Setting

- Kenya writing workshops give students all the information in option 1, plus the opportunity to doing more one-on-one work on writing. Carrie also offers details about life in Kenya, culture, Swahili words, and writing process.

*** If you have done option 1, deeper topics covered will be deeper topics from the areas in that option, not the same topics over again.**

The kids will pen pal write with kids from Kenya -- Carrie will take letter to Kenya and have that same classroom age send notes back to your children.

option 3:

MICRO-ENTERPRISE CURRICULUM

>> Classroom Setting

- Micro-Enterprise Curriculum is designed for schools and civic groups across the country to understand the importance of good business and the role of micro-enterprises in worldwide communities, including their own.

Through various phases of the curriculum, students will uncover the basics of business and marketing, create their own business plans, learn how to create a budget, and discover how micro-enterprises are impacting the environment and their communities.

- There are four levels: Elementary, Middle, High, and Homeschool. Each level is broken into five Modules: General Business, General Marketing, Micro-Enterprise Fundamentals, Creating a Micro-Enterprise Business Plan, and Finance. Each module contains a student workbook and corresponding teacher's guide, complete with definitions, class discussions, role play activities, student worksheets, and optional assignments.
