Undergraduate Programs

LICU offers a variety of seven academic programs. Starting with year 1, which is the foundational requirement for every student studying at LICU. Undergraduate programs incorporate four years of course work, accumulating 30 credit hours a year and concluding the total of 123 undergraduate hours by submitting a 50 page bachelor's thesis (*worth 3 credit hours*) at the end of the fourth year.

The first 3 years are divided into 9 courses at 3 credit hours each plus 1 ministry practicum at 3 credit hours, making a total of 30 credit hours. The fourth year requires in addition to the 9 courses and the ministry practicum, a 50 page bachelor's thesis (*worth 3 credit hours*).

Available Degrees

The following Christian degrees are made available through LICU's undergraduate programs.

- Bachelor of Arts in Pastoral Ministry* (*123 credit hours*)
- Bachelor of Christian Education (*123 credit hours*)
- Bachelor of Science in Christian Education* (*123 credit hours*)
- Bachelor of Church Administration (*123 credit hours*)
- Bachelor of Science in Church Administration* (*123 credit hours*)

*To receive a degree of "Arts" or "Science," students have to fulfil (*or transfer*) at least 30 credit hours of general education.

Entrance Requirements

To enter LICU's undergraduate studies a *high school diploma* is required. Students who have not fulfilled high school graduation have the opportunity to fulfil two substitute years at our university to replace their high school qualification. During this time they do not have to take exams nor write papers, receiving "*Certificates of Completion.*" After these two years they would automatically enter the degree program and accumulate credits towards their "*Diploma of Theology.*"



The first three years incorporate each one track in *Christian Theology*. They are designed to give each student a solid foundation for their life and ministry.

Year 1: Diploma in Theology

This foundational year of LifeStyle International Christian University is a powerful set of courses designed to give each student solid footing for their supernatural life and ministry in Christ. After these life-altering courses, each student will be better equipped to operate in their God given authority.

Definition: *A diploma (from Greek διπλωμα. diplóma, meaning "folded paper") is a certificate or deed issued by an educational institution, such as a university, that testifies that the recipient has successfully completed a particular course of study, or confers an academic degree [<http://en.wikipedia.org>].*

Year 2: Associate (of Arts) in Theology

Following the completion of the Foundational Year, LICU students continue their journey by studying such powerful and transformational courses as: life and teachings of Christ, the apostolic, healing and deliverance, Holy Spirit, His indwelling presence and successful intercession.

Definition: *An associate's degree is an undergraduate academic degree awarded by community colleges, junior colleges, technical colleges, and bachelor's degree-granting colleges and universities upon completion of a course of study usually lasting two years [<http://en.wikipedia.org>].*

Year 3: Advanced Diploma in Theology

Continuing upon the powerful foundation laid in the initial two years of LICU, year 3 travels further into an expansive range of subjects such as: Old and New Testaments, ordination for impartation and anointing for the assignment. This 3rd year will advance your journey with God to broaden your impact in this generation.

Definition: *An award requiring two or three years full-time, or equivalent part-time, study. The Advanced Diploma is the highest of the undergraduate diploma awards [<http://www.mondofacto.com>].*

Year 4: Four Specific Baccalaureate Tracks

The fourth year of LICU offers 4 specific baccalaureate tracks, which offer a powerful continuation on this powerful supernatural journey that explores the deeper things of God. Building on the 3 previous years, the 4th year tracks include: #1 Christian Theology, #2 Pastoral Ministry, #3 Christian Education, #4 Church Administration. As each student increases their capacity as revelatory thinkers and writers, they begin to experience new levels of expertise never thought possible!

Definition: *A bachelor's degree is usually an academic degree awarded for an undergraduate course or major that generally lasts for three or four years, but can range anywhere from two to six years depending on the region of the world [<http://en.wikipedia.org>].*
