## Third-World Scholarships for Correspondence Students

*(Admin & courses will be administrated through email/attachments only)*

*The following fees apply for all LICU correspondence students living in “third world countries” and are being made available by our President Doctor Pateman and the Executive Board for you to reach your desired degree! It is Doctor Pateman’s heart and desire to see as many people as possible benefit from these revelation filled studies and for you to have an even greater impact in your life and ministry!*

### Application and Start-up Fees

- Application fee: £15 (normally 30£, **saving 15£**) – **50%**
- MLE application: £15 (normally 30£, **saving 15£**) – **50%**
- MLE award:
  - £5 per undergraduate hour
  - 1 year/30 credit hours max: £150 (normally 270£, **saving £120**) – **44%**
  - £7.50 per graduate hour
  - 3 courses/9 credit hours max: £67.50 (normally 117£, **saving £49.50**) – **42%**
- Matriculation fee: £150 (if someone transfers in with sufficient credits for a bachelor degree for example) (normally 260£, **saving £110**) – **42%**

### Course Tuitions (per course/3 credit hours)

Your course tuition covers your student fees, the 3 credit hours per course and the administration of the academic student affairs (*including the processing of course exams and research papers etc.*) Not included are textbooks, which you may order at your local bookstore. Also you will receive a **student’s handbook** at the beginning of your studies, which is the first course you are studying as part of your enrolment requirements. The fee for this first course is £20.

- Undergraduate £20 (normally: £150, **saving £130**) – **87%**
- Graduate (Master) £25 (normally: £185, **saving £160**) – **87%**
- Post-Graduate (Doctorate) £25 (normally: £200, **saving £175**) – **87%**

### Regarding Text Books

Textbook reading requirements apply to all students studying for their master and doctoral degrees. Undergraduate students (*years 1-4, including bachelor students*) have the option of reading the books listed as “recommended reading,” which will be accredited to them as a bonus and can serve the improvement of their final grade (*e.g.: an “B” becomes a “B+”*).



## Writing Tasks (professional binding of finished writing tasks is calculated extra)

Students who have reached the level of their bachelor thesis for the completion of their bachelor degree have already saved **4,680 Pounds** in regards to the 87% scholarship that they have been granted. Students finishing their master degree save a total of **6,120 Pounds** in tuition payments.

For doctoral students, the total saving at the time of starting their dissertation for a Doctor of Ministry is **6,980 Pounds** in tuition payments **and an additional 500 Pounds** for their writing task. By the time they have finished their Doctor of Philosophy degree, which is the final step in their academic journey at LICU, ***their total savings will have accumulated to 8,640 Pounds!***

Also, the prices listed below for your writing tasks cover the credit hours as well as the entire editing process, including the approval of prospected proposals, reviewing of initial drafts, marking/grading of final version, reviewing and approval of amended submission. This entire process can take up to 2 weeks of fulltime involvement of respective faculty advisors and our Editorial Consultant.

Since LICU is offering degrees to students internationally regardless of their location, it is still important to remember that the costs that need to be covered at the Head Office for these writing tasks are based on European salaries and therefore cannot be discounted in the same way as the course tuitions leading up to the completion of these degrees. Furthermore these LICU degrees are ***once-in-a-lifetime achievements*** that will not lose their value and the cost of writing a bachelor or master thesis for example could be compared to the purchase of a mobile phone, which is an investment most people are willing to make!

- Bachelor thesis (50 pages - 3 credits) £260
- Master thesis (80 pages - 6 credits) £440
- Doctoral dissertation (150 pages - 30 credits) £1,000 (normally: £1,500, **saving £500**) – **33%**
- Doctoral dissertation (200 pages - 30 credits) £1,200 (normally: £1,500, **saving £300**) – **20%**

## Certificate Fees including Official Transcript

- Per certificate: £50 (extra for P&P)

## Graduation Regalia

These can be purchased at our office. Prices depend on graduation level. For example a Premium Graduation Cap & Gown Package for undergraduate students (*incl. tassel with year tag*) costs £32 plus postage. Please contact our office for further details.

## Graduation Fees for Students attending our main International Graduation Ceremony

This includes certificate fee & hiring of graduation regalia (*students may keep their tassel with year tag*).

- Undergraduate students (years 1-3) – £130
- Bachelor, master & doctorates (years 4-7) – £160



**Note:** The prices listed for graduation fees cover certificate and transcript fees, as well as hiring of graduation regalia, including the customised graduation hood for bachelor, master and doctoral students - representing their degree, as well as the colours of this university. All students may keep their tassel with year tag.
