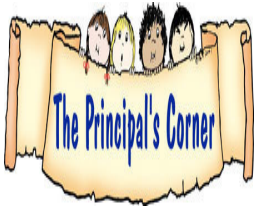

This program is a state-wide program that allows families to apply for state aid that will cover your tuition cost of attending St. Peter's School. Currently this program is available for the 2018-2019 school year for St. Peter's students entering PRE-K 4, Kindergarten and 1st grade, or students that are new to St. Peter's in PRE-K 4 - 8th grade. Applications may be found online at <http://dpi.wi.gov/sms/choice-programs/student-applications>. Applications are being accepted February 1st - April 20th, 2018. There will be an opportunity for you to ask questions of the Board of Christian Education on Monday, February 12th at 7:00 p.m. The meeting will be held in the 8th grade classroom.
