Gym Safety and Enhancements: You probably have heard about the Gala project this year, Gym Safety and Enhancements, but what does that mean? (A good Lutheran question)

The gym is safe, but we want to make it even safer. Currently the mats on the North and South walls cover the area behind the baskets. The plan is to replace those mats with new mats that cover the entire baseline of the court.

The gym enhancements involve adding a Traversing Wall. It is like a climbing wall but you travel sideways rather than up. This would be located on the walls in the southwest corner of the gym where the equipment is stored. The wall would have mats covering them when they are not in use. Those same mats lay on the floor under the Traversing Wall when it is in use. Finally, we would like to give the gym a fresh coat of paint.
