
NATIONAL YOUTH GATHERING FUNDRAISER

Second Round Safety Grant Approved!

I found out this week that our Round 2 Safety Grant has been approved by the Department of Justice. This Grant along with a generous gift will allow St. Peter's to make the following upgrades to the safety of our students and staff. **Safety Deadbolt Door Locks**- push a button and the door is secured with a deadbolt. **Safety Film**- makes entry through a treated window very difficult if not impossible. **Blackout Lock Down Shades** for classroom doors, and developing a School Safety Team and Adolescent Mental Health training. These enhancements combined with Round 1 Intercom and Motion Lighting are all designed to make our students and staff even safer.

American Legion Visit:

The American Legion Post #350 visited the 8th grade. The purpose of the visit was to explain the requirements of the American Legion Citizenship Award. This will be the first time the American Legion Post 350 will present the award to one boy and one girl from each eighth-grade class in the Reedsburg School District.



Principal Chat/Survey Results Continued:
