This was especially true in regards to form fitting short, pants or leggings and the required outer garment that reached the middle of the thigh.

Dress Code has been an emotional topic at every school I have served. I have developed some thoughts on Dress Code over my years of service. I will share those thoughts in a special edition of the Tiger Print in December. The Dress Code Special Edition will also share information from the Board of Christian Education regarding the Dress Code in an attempt to clarify the expectations.
