## Dress Code Special Edition Summary:

The Dress Code applies to all students in Pre-Kindergarten through 8th grade.

Specific Dress Code topics clarified include:

Undergarments must not be exposed.

Shirts must cover skin that should be covered. This requirement includes exposure of skin that should be covered regardless of arm or body position.

Form Fitting shorts, pants or leggings must have an outer garment that covers to mid-thigh or longer.

The interpretation of mid-thigh for the remainder of the 18-19 school year will be as it was in past school years. One example of what was acceptable in the past was an outer garment that covered only the bottom.

Starting in the 2019-2020 school year, mid -thigh will be defined as all the way around. In other words, the outer garment must cover the back, front and sides at a minimum of mid-thigh at any point around the legs.

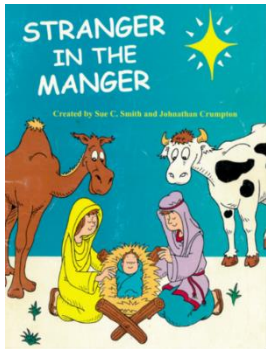
