Have you noticed the pink lines on the curbs along Locust and North Pine street?

Those

are markings the City of Reedsburg made to identify the 2019-2020 Bus Zone and Car Line areas. Next school year the Pine Street entrance will be used for all Bus loading and unloading. The Locust street entrance will be used for the Car Line. The Car Line is for families who prefer to drop off and pick up their children without getting out of the car. The parking lot will be used exclusively by families who wish to park and walk their children into and out of the building. This change is being made to provide a safer procedure for students and their families at the start and end of the day. More details will be coming in August.
