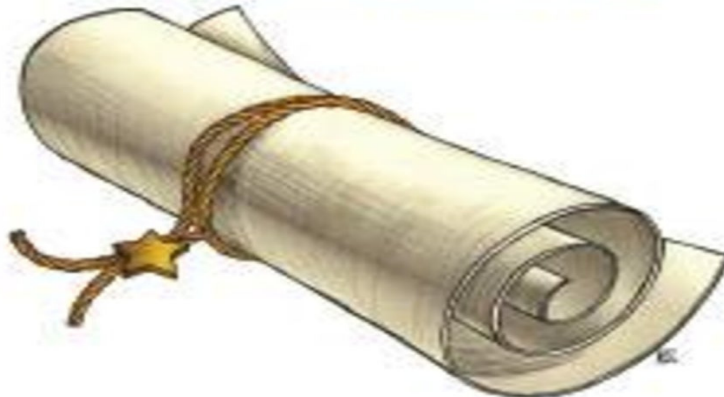

5:30 PM – 8:00 PM

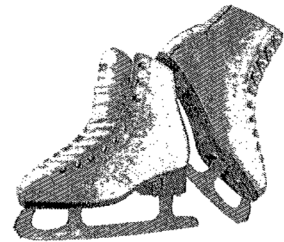
