CAPSTONE MINISTRIES

The Chapel offerings for the 2nd quarter will be given to Capstone Ministries. This ministry works with street children in Kisumu. Kisumu is the largest city in western Kenya. Capstone believes that family is the divine structure God designed for the rearing of children. Family provides the necessary protective environment in which children can grow and develop. More than 1,000 children live on the streets of Kisumu. They survive by begging and stealing. They suffer from skin diseases, abuse, poor nutrition and lack of sanitation. But mostly they lack love and attention of a nurturing family. Daily, the staff of Capstone is on the street showing these children the love of God in Jesus Christ. Through counseling and an ongoing outreach program, the boys are reunited with their families. We hope to have Pastor Schmelzer, the director of Capstone Ministries, visit St. Peter's this quarter to share more about this ministry.

Annual Asbestos Notification

2019-2020 School Year Under the AHERA (Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act) rule, all primary and secondary schools are required to develop and implement a plan for managing all building materials which contain asbestos. Included in the AHERA Act is the requirement to annually notify all workers and building occupants (or their guardians) of asbestos-related activities.

St. Peter's was inspected by EPA accredited inspectors, with building material samples analyzed by an independent laboratory. Based on the inspection, St. Peter's prepared and the state approved a comprehensive management plan for managing the asbestos.

St. Peter's has in place an Operations and Maintenance program where the asbestos-containing materials were found. A 3-Year re-inspection was conducted by MacNeil Environmental Inc. on Oct. 28, 2019. All areas, except one, were found to be in good condition. The one area with some damage and **potential** fiber release was found in the HVAC room. This is located in a remote area of the building away from any children or staff. Repairs to this area will occur on the afternoon of Friday Nov. 8, 2019 after the Parent Teacher conferences are over.
