**PRACTICE BEGINS** Monday, October 28.

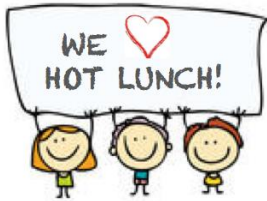
B-Team will practice from 3:30-5. A-Team will practice 5-6:30 pm.

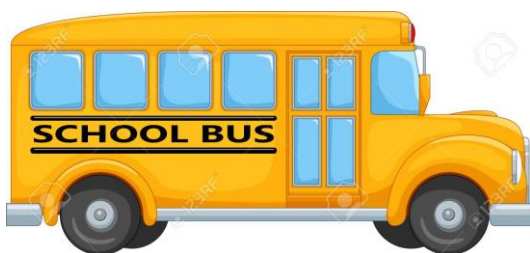
