## **Tax Information from WCRIS**

Tax season is quickly approaching and a simple form can help you deduct your tuition costs on your State Income Taxes.

This deduction saves private and parochial school families \$8 million a year. The state has budgeted nearly \$12 million a year, so there is room for more families to use it.

The Wisconsin Department of Revenue released the 2019 Schedule PS Private School Tuition Tax deduction form.
