## PRINCIPAL CHAT SUMMARY

The Chat started with statistics from the survey taken in April, 2019. A review of the safety improvements made in the past two years was also shared. The improvements include: security cameras, video controlled entry for each classroom in the lower level, blackout shades added to classrooms, window film added throughout the school, updated AED, walkie talkies for teachers and office, new school intercom, background checks expanded to include chaperones on field trips, Threat Assessment Team in place, intruder drills practiced, the drop-off and pick-up of students has been revised and SafeBolt door locks to be installed soon.
