Special points of interest

- Fireworks display will begin at dusk across the street in the farm field North of the Campground by the Hartford City Fire Department. Please roll-up all awnings to prevent damage from debris or an errant firework. Neither Wildwood or the Hartford City Fire Department are liable for losses.
- Hand held sparklers are the only fireworks allowed in the park.

Just a few Wildwood guidelines to insure everyone has a safe and enjoyable 4th of July holiday:

For emergency service dial **911** then call Wildwood at 765-348-2100 and we'll make sure they fin your site promptly.

Restrooms and showers are located on the West side of the Recreation Center and are open 24 hours.

Campers, please advise all guests that the **speed limit throughout the park is 5 miles per hour**. To protect our pedestrian traffic violators will become pedestrians for their stay.

> All **sites are limited to parking two vehicles**. Additional overflow parking is available near the Recreation Center or Sycamore Bog. Vehicles are prohibited from driving across or being parked on lawns or empty campsites.

Quite hours are from 11:00 P.M to 8:00 A.M.

Swimming pool is **open** from **9:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M.** Children under 17 years of age must be accompanied and supervised by a parent. Please follow all other rules posted at the pool.

> **Golf Cars** may be operated only **by a licensed driver** after registering them for an **annual fee of \$25.00** and providing proof of **liability insurance.** Golf car speed limit is 5 miles per hour and must remain on roads after dark.

This is a family park, **alcoholic beverages must remain at campsite**

Campers, please advise **visitors** they **must check-in at office** before proceeding to campsites. **A \$2.00 fee applies to visitors** which are not registered on a site. Additional fees apply to them to swim, fish or spend the night.
