

## DKC/DAD FAST CAT TEST RULES AND INFORMATION

- ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNERS SOLE RISK
- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- Dogs will NOT be required to wear muzzles
- White and/or black plastic bags will be used for the lure.
- Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test for lack of condition, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded.
- All AKC Rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.
- This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly.
- Please bring your own shade/rain cover, and chairs. City water is available on site.
- Dogs are not allowed to wait on the field. Please plan to crate your dog if you plan to spectate.
- Electronic timers will be used. An electric, continuous loop will be used.
- Porta-potties are on site.
- Dogs must be under control on lead or crated unless running.
- A \$5 fine/per dog per occurrence will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing or for not picking up after yourself and your dog.
- YOU are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and children.
- Each dog requires an individual entry form indicating tests in which it is entered. Entries will not be accepted without fees (checks made to DAD), signatures, or the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form. **Please use ONE ENTRY FORM for each dog for all tests you plan for that dog.** You do not need separate entry forms for each test.
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. Entry fees will be refunded.
- The Huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve a testing dog.
- Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running.

No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.

### Events on Friday, Aug. 2, 2019:

#### **TWO TESTS WILL RUN CONCURRENTLY**

**DAY OF TEST ENTRIES CLOSE:** Noon for both tests.

**CHECK-IN & INSPECTION: 1:00 - 2:00 p.m.** Dogs not checked in and inspected by 2:00 p.m. will be scratched and entry fees will NOT be refunded. During this window, every effort will be made to accommodate agility competitors; however, agility competitors must check in during this time.

**TESTS: 2:00 - 5:00 P.M.** Dogs that have not run by 5:00 P.M. will be scratched and entry fees will NOT be refunded.

### Events on Saturday, Aug. 4, 2018:

#### **TWO TESTS WILL RUN CONCURRENTLY**

**DAY OF TEST ENTRIES CLOSE:** Noon for both tests.

**CHECK-IN & INSPECTION: 1:00 - 2:00 p.m.** Dogs not checked in and inspected by 2:00 p.m. will be scratched and entry fees will NOT be refunded. During this window, every effort will be made to accommodate agility competitors; however, agility competitors must check in during this time.

**TESTS: 2:00 - 5:00 P.M.** Dogs that have not run by 5:00 P.M. will be scratched and entry fees will NOT be refunded.

## CRITICAL NOTES

- **NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE FIELD WITHOUT THE EXPRESS PERMISSION OF THE FIELD CHAIRMAN, EXCEPT THE APPOINTED FIELD COMMITTEE.**

- All teams must wait out of sight of the test area.
- **ONLY** the dog being tested is allowed on the field.
- Spectators may not have dogs in view of the test area.
- Bitches in season and lame canines at inspection will be excused and their entry fee refunded.
- Aggressive dogs will be dismissed without refund.
- ALL entrants **MUST** check-in during check-in time and complete tests prior to 5:00 p.m., no exceptions. Check in and run order consideration will be given to dogs competing in the Durango Kennel Club agility trial; however, **agility competitors MUST** check-in and be inspected during the official check-in time and complete tests before 5:00 p.m. the day of tests entered. Many of the FastCAT workers compete in agility, so it is important for them to keep time windows precise.
- **TWO-LEASHES and TWO HANDLERS ARE REQUIRED.** A handler with leash at the start and a handler with leash at the finish.
- Equipment is continuous loop. Back-up equipment (drag line) is on hand.

## ENTRY FEES

**Pre-entry fees** \$20.00 for each test (per dog per test)

**Day of Test entries** \$25.00 per each entry (per dog per test) at the secretary's station, at the times quoted for each test.

## FAST CAT REGULATIONS

FAST CAT Tests are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Females in season may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event (an event is defined by an event number).

## ABOUT FAST CAT

Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs.

Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced and dogs are run individually.

### EARNING POINTS

A. The dog's time to complete the 100 yard dash is converted into MPH.

**MPH = (204.545)/dog's time.**

B. A handicap system is applied to a dog's MPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

- 18" or greater = handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = handicap is 1.5
- Below 12" = handicap is 2.0

C. Points = MPH multiplied by the dog's handicap

**SUFFIX TITLES** are earned by accumulating points. The following suffix titles will be awarded:

**BCAT** = 150 Points;

**DCAT** = 500 points;

**FCAT** = 1,000 points; and

**FCAT** followed by a number (e.g. FCAT 2) for every additional 500 points. **These suffix titles will appear on the dog's pedigree, with a higher level title superseding a lower level title.**

- **Ribbons will be awarded for qualifying runs.**

*A penalty of \$5 will be assessed for each loose dog not competing in the course in progress, and/or for 5+ minute delay of event.*


#### DIRECTIONS TO SITE

From Durango: Drive west on Hwy 160 towards Mancos. Take a right at light in Mancos onto CO-184 North. Go 17.4 miles. Turn right on CO 145. Go 1.5 miles and turn right at Joe Rowell Park.

From Farmington: West on W Broadway/US-64 W. Turn right onto US 491. Go 41.4 mi. Keep right to stay on US 160 E/ SR789/W Main St. E. Go 2.5 mi. Turn left onto SR 145/State St. Go 5.1 mi. End at Joe Rowell Park.

From Bloomfield, NM: North on 550 thru Bloomfield to Aztec. Turn left on W. Aztec Blvd. for .9 miles, the right onto N. Light Plant Road. After 14 miles there will be a right onto 170, which becomes 140 when it crosses into CO. In Hesperus, turn left onto 160 W. And follow directions from Durango.

From southeast Utah: From SR 98. Turn left onto US 160 E. Go 44.2 mi. Keep right to stay on US 160. Go 2.5 mi. Turn left onto SR 145/ State St. Go 5.1 mi. End at Joe Rowell Park.



*The FastCAT field is closed to dogs from the time the field is setup for FastCAT until the end of FastCAT on Saturday evening. Please exercise your dog(s) in one of the many other areas during this time.*

**During FastCAT, ONLY the competing dog is allowed on the FastCAT field.**
