I give my child permission to participate in the Rambler Youth Football Association Cheering Program for Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th graders. My Child will Receive a Uniform Containing 1 Shell Top, 1 Skirt Bottom and 1 Pair Of Maroon Boy Shorts that must be returned at the end of the last game of the season in an undamaged form or my uniform deposit will not be returned. Cheerleaders are Required to purchase white sneakers and a maroon crop top turtle neck as a part of their uniform. Cheerleaders will be given 1 pair of white socks and 1 hair bow that they may keep but must be worn as part of the uniform. There will be no eating, painting nails etc in uniform that may cause any damage. Boy shorts MUST be worn OVER undergarments. Once uniform is returned in an undamaged form a check for \$20 will be given by the Rambler Youth Football Association. A parent/ Guardian is required to sign up for 1 time slot at the Concession Stand during the season. I give the Rambler Youth Football Association Coaches and Staff permission to use Cheering related pictures of my child on their website and any other advertising for the program.

Permission for Medical Treatment

In case of an emergency, I give permission for the adults in charge to arrange for emergency treatment by rescue personnel, including transportation to a hospital if necessary, but not to include any surgery that may be required. I agree to not hold said organization, officers, directors, sponsors, coaches, the Town of Winthrop, Maine or any other persons or benefactors of Rambler Youth Football Association liable for any injury received by my child in said program. I am informed that this is a Cheering program with stunting, tumbling and jumping. **I UNDERSTAND THAT I WILL BE LIABLE FOR ALL COST ON ANY MEDICAL BILL FOR ANY INJURIES TO MY SON OR DAUGHTER.** With my signature I verify that my son or daughter is fit to do Cheering.

Code of Conduct

I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of any personal desire to win. I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.

I will provide support for coaches and officials working with my child to provide a positive, enjoyable experience for all.

I will demand a drug, alcohol, and tobacco-free sports environment for my child and agree to assist by refraining from their use at all sports events.

I will remember that the game is for the children and not the adults.

I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child.

I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.

I will promise to help my child enjoy the youth sports experience within my personal constraints by assisting with coaching, being a respectful fan, providing transportation, or whatever I am capable of doing.

I will require that my child's coach be trained in the responsibilities of being a youth sports coach and that the coach agree to the youth sports Coaches Code of Ethics.

I will bring any concerns I have to the coaches.

I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice, or other youth sports event.

Emergency Procedures

1. Evaluate athlete at the location, obtain the best medical advice available at the time.
2. If emergency treatment is necessary, call for transport. Make sure to ascertain the location of hospital/medical center where injured athlete is being taken.
3. An assistant coach, head coach, or adult should always accompany the injured athlete.
4. Notify parents as soon as possible of injury or transport. (Whenever possible, do immediately).
5. Send emergency card with athlete.
6. At the conclusion of the contest, make sure that arrangements have been made for the injured athlete to get home.

I realize that my participation as a player or other representative of this program is a privilege, one that can and will be removed for inappropriate/unsportsmanlike conduct or disrespect to coaches, officials, or other team members. I will respect all decisions made by game officials, coaches and parents. I will be a positive role model in my community.
