## Statute of RedGob

1. RedGob - Red Euro-Latinoamericana de Gobernabilidad para el Desarrollo is a network of European and Latin American academic institutions which conduct research pertaining to the Latin American experience.

2. RedGob's core purpose is to create a space for reflection about the topics of governability, public policy and development in Europe, Latin America and the Caribbean. The main objectives are, to promote research, debate and generation of knowledge; to advance thoughtful consideration to the diverse European experiences and to increase the exchange between researchers and decision makers from Europe and Latin America.

3. RedGob is open to all European and Latin American institutions undertaking research on Latin America. Accession to RedGob is decided by the assembly of the member institutions.

4. The main activity of RedGob is the organization of an annual meeting that is planned and hosted by one of the member organizations.

---

5. Decisions of RedGob are taken by the assembly of the member organizations by majority vote. The quorum for the assembly is 60% of the member organizations. The assembly meets at least once a year during the annual meeting.

---

6. Member institutions have the obligation to participate in the activities of the network. The assembly of the member institutions can decide over the disaffiliation of a member institution for lack of activities within RedGob. Such a decision can only be taken by an absolute majority of all member organizations.

---

7. The Pro Tempore Presidency of RedGob is rotated each year between the member organizations. The organizer of the annual meeting becomes the president up to the next conference and is in charge of the secretariat of RedGob.

8. RedGob will maintain a Website to inform about the activities and an electronic archive of the documents of the organization.
