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GCMS Standards Based Reporting Rubric

Student Earned Score	The score means...
Mastery (M) I know it! I can perform it! I can teach it to others!	Student understands this standard or exercise and can teach others key concepts. Student is very consistent with the small details and information. Student is mastery in 3 of 4 performance areas.
Progressing (P) I know and can do most of it by myself	Student is making progress which means they can do most of it by themselves. They are consistently and/or independently applying big concepts but need a little help with the details. They should become consistent with their practice logs to master what is expected. Student is mastery in 2 performance areas, and progressing in two other areas
Limited (L) I know (can perform) all the easy parts, but I don't know (can't perform) the harder parts	Student understands most of what is taught but struggles with the more difficult content parts. They can process the information with assistance of peers, teacher or book. They need to complete practice logs and should practice 20-30 minutes per night. Tutoring after school will be available for these students. Student is either progressing or limited in all areas, allowed one NY in one area
Not yet performing (NY) Needs Support: I don't understand, even with help	Student understands little to none of what was taught. They cannot process the information with assistance from peers, teacher and/or book. They need to complete practice logs and should practice 20-30 minutes per night. Tutoring after school will be available for these students. Teacher will contact parents or guardians to create a plan of action. Student needs support in two or more areas
Incomplete (I) I refuse to demonstrate my knowledge (I refuse to play in band class or come prepared)	Parent will be contacted at this time. If this continues we may get other personnel from the school involved to assist with a plan to help your student become successful. Student does not perform or has all NY in all areas

If a student wishes to retake an assessment (mandatory for NY or I reporting), students must complete a practice log for an entire week. This will be used as a formative/product grade. A parent must sign practice log and 100 minutes must be logged with all exercises practiced. Practice logs are available online and will be readily available from Mr. McGrannahan.
