Thank you Ron and Nancy for your tireless efforts throughout the year and setting the Elks on a steady course for success.

The Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks has never been stronger or more relevant than it is today and our Lodge is certainly doing its part with the work we do with Youth, Veterans, Drug Awareness and the list goes on. By joining together and working together as a "TEAM", we will continue to be one of the best Lodges in the Nation and we will continue to make our Lodge a comfortable and inviting home away from home for our members and their families, and prove ourselves an even stronger partner for our community.





## PUBLIC RELATIONS




## **ELKS FUNERAL RITUAL**


