WHERE TO FIND GOLD IN ALBERTA

- The Red Deer River near Innisfail, as well as the City of Red Deer, on an inside bend, below the surface gravel, on the upstream face of the bar (below the Joffre bridge in July and August).
- On the McLeod River between Hinton and Whitecourt, from below Hargwen to a point near Marlboro, from Rosevear to 6 miles below the Peers bridge.
- On the North Saskatchewan River from below the rapids near Rocky Mountain House to about 15 miles below Fort Saskatchewan. The fine gold is found on the upstream end of the gravel bars just below the surface between the low and high water levels.
- On the Athabasca River between Whitecourt and Fort Assiniboine.
- On the Peace River near the Town of Peace River in bank gravel 200 to 300 feet above the water level in the upper two feet or so.

The AGPA hosts 3 official events per year.

The first event (The Spring Breakout) is held in May or June at a location identified in the AGPA Gold Rush Newsletter.

During this outing, there is a gold panning competition for all skill levels. Other fun activities include metal detecting, pan toss, dirt toss etc. The winner of the AGPA Pro Category is then recognized as an elite panner at other competitions. Many members camp during this weekend event, which includes dinner on Saturday night provided by the club.

The second, more casual campout takes place in the fall (Corn Roast). This is also a "Show us What You Got Event". Members bring their gold, gem stones, and anything they have collected or worked on over the summer. There are prizes for categories such as pictures, gold displays, rock displays, jewellery and metal detector findings. The club also provides corn for the potluck supper that happens on the Saturday night.

In November, the club holds the Gold Dust Dinner and Silent Auction to close out the prospecting season.

The Gold Rush Newsletter is issued 4 times a year, which expands on the above mentioned activities so that members know exactly where and when to go.
